	 For international transfer applicants (international applicants who have attended a post-secondary institution) Official transcripts, mark sheets and degree certificates in the official language(s) of issue from EVERY college or university you attended and make sure they meet <u>credential requirements</u>. Applicants who complete less than one year at a non-U.S. college or university and applicants with fewer than 15 transferrable semester hours from a U.S. college or university must also submit official secondary school credentials (and SAT or ACT scores, if required).
	Original literal English translations . Documents not issued in English must be translated into English by the issuing institution or an authorized translator. If documents are translated by a U.S. translator, the translator must be a certified member of the American Translators Association. Evaluations of transcripts are not accepted.

	SAT or ACT scores are optional but strongly recommended.
