FORMER STUDENT READMISSION CRITERIA

Students reapplying from suspension as well as students ready to return after an interruption of at least four consecutive semesters must apply for readmission as a former student. Regardless of academic standing, you are required to meet college-specific re-entry requirements and deadlines.

The University of Houston considers all courses in the readmission grade point average. This includes UH and non-UH courses.

Note: all college-level coursework attempted from all U.S. regionally accredited institutions will be used in computing the grade point average, including Fs and repeated courses.

STEPS TO COMPLETE A READMISSION APPLICATION

- 1 Submit a Former Student Application through ApplyTexas.org.
- 2 Submit the \$75 non-refundable application fee.
- 3 Send updated official transcripts from all colleges and institutions previously attended since your last semester at UH. Also submit official transcripts for previously attempted coursework that has not been evaluated for transfer credit. *Electronic transcripts are preferred.*

Monitor your To-Do List for additional documents that may be required.
