Dean's Collaborative Interdisciplinary Summer Research Award for International Engagement

The Dean's Collaborative Interdisciplinary Summer Research Award serves to foster interdisciplinary international engagement among roster faculty in CLASS. The intent of this award is to assist in collaborations and must yield the development of a co-authored work or proposed course on the region. There must be three colleagues involved. At least two must be roster faculty members from different departments and/or programs within CLASS, and all must be faculty members within CLASS. Proposing faculty members are to submit an application that details the nature of the collaboration, intended outcome(s), international location engaged, and proposed timeline for the outcome(s).

There will be one, \$10,000 award given annually. Faculty clusters may receive this award only once. Project descriptions will have a maximum length of two, double spaced pages with 12- point font. Additionally, proposals require a budget, a budget justification, and a maximum two page CV for each faculty member. The CLASS Research Committee will do the first round of reviews, thus the proposals should be aimed at a general academic audience. The application deadline is Friday, October 12, 2018, at 5 pm. Please submit application materials to classgrt@uh.edu with "Dean's Collaborative Interdisciplinary Summer Research Award" in the subject line.

Recipients of the Collaborative Interdisciplinary Summer Research Award are required to submit a progress report by August 31, 2019.
