The Fischoff Competition is the largest chamber music competition in the nation and the world.

The Seraphim Quartet, formed three years ago, includes Eric Laine (junior) soprano saxophone, Clinton Ross (junior) alto saxophone, Zach Woolhouse (senior) tenor saxophone, and Evan Withner (senior) baritone saxophone. The Ikiryo Quartet, now in its second semester, includes James Sterling (senior) soprano saxophone Kevin Tang (senior) alto saxophone, Xiao Liu (Master's student) tenor saxophone, and Nick Tieh (senior) baritone saxophone.

The **Moores School of Music Trumpet Ensemble** has advanced to the semi-final round of the 2014 National Trumpet Competition on the campus of the Messiah College on March 20 - 23, 2014 in Mechanicsburg, PA. Inaugurated in 1992, NTC has provided performing opportunities, master classes, exhibition concerts, historic and commercial exhibits and an educational, supportive environment for nearly 3,000 students.
