He teaches at the School of Communications in Bogotá, and he is a member of the Fundación Gabriel García Márquez para el Nuevo Periodismo Iberoamericano (FNPI). In his *crónicas* he portrays Colombian popular culture through a wide range of characters and stories. His work has appeared in publications like *SoHo* and *El Malpensante* (Colombia), as well as *Etiqueta Negra* (Perú), *Gatopardo* (México); *Ecos* (Germany), and *Internazionale* (Italy).

**Daniel Centeno** is a Venezuelan journalist with an MFA from The University of Texas at El Paso and a PhD from the University Complutense of Madrid. He has published his interviews and stories about artists and famous rebels in *Retratos Hablados* and *Ogros Ejemplares*. He is the editor-in-chief of the literary magazine *Río Grande Review*).
