The Department of Hispanic Studies Scholarship Committee is receiving applications from eligible students for the *Halpern/Kanellos* Scholarship. This scholarship has been made available by a generous gift from Leslie Halpern, an alumnus of the University of Houston, in memory of his father and mother, and in honor of Professor Nicolás Kanellos. This scholarship is for the 2015-16 academic year or reimbursement for academic expenses for Summer 2015. We anticipate awarding One (1) scholarship of **\$500.00**.

Eligibility:

Undergraduate students who are majoring in Spanish, Spanish Teacher Education or Bilingual Education.

Requirements:

Students must have earned at least six semester hours in Spanish at the third-year level from the University of Houston and have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Materials to be submitted to the Committee:

1. A letter (1 page) in Spanish stating career goals related to the Spanish or Bilingual Education major and the reasons for these goals.
2. Two letters of recommendation. (Please use the form posted on the departmental website: <http://www.uh.edu/class/spanish/>). These letters should come from authorities who know the applicant's scholarly work and/or career plans and personal traits.
