The Department of Hispanic Studies Scholarship Committee is receiving applications from eligible students for the Dr. Harvey L. Johnson Scholarship. This scholarship has been made available by a generous gift from the Johnson Family in memory of Dr. Harvey L. Johnson, a former University of Houston Spanish Professor. This scholarship is for the 2015-2016 academic year or reimbursement for the academic expenses for Summer 2015 and will be awarded in Fall 2015. We anticipate awarding four scholarships of \$1,000.00, depending upon available funds and the merits of the statements and letters of recommendation submitted by the applicants.

Eligibility:

Graduate students in the Department of Hispanic Studies.

Requirements:

Students must have earned at least nine semester hours in Spanish at the Graduate level from the University of Houston and have a minimum GPA of 3.5. Students must be citizens of the United States of America.

Materials to be submitted to the Committee:

1. A letter (1 page) in Spanish stating career goals.
