

Dr. Harvey L. Johnson Scholarship for Graduate Students

Scholarship recipient will be acknowledged at the Hispanic Studies award ceremony on April 24, 2015 from 4:00-6:00pm at Arte Público Press.

The Department of Hispanic Studies Scholarship Committee is receiving applications form eligible students for the Dr. Harvey L. Johnson Scholarship. This scholarship has been made available by a generous gift from the Johnson Family in memory of Dr. Harvey L. Johnson, a former University of Houston Spanish Professor. This scholarship is for the 2015-2016 academic year or reimbursement for the academic expenses for Summer 2015 and will be awarded in Fall 2015. We anticipate awarding four scholarships of \$1,000.00, depending upon available funds and the merits of the statements and letters of recommendation submitted by the applicants.

Eligibility:

Graduate students in the Department of Hispanic Studies.

Requirements:

Students must have earned at least nine semester hours in Spanish at the Graduate level from the University of Houston and have a minimum GPA of 3.5. Students must be citizens of the United States of America.

Materials to be submitted to the Committee:

- 1. A letter (1 page) in Spanish stating career goals.
