## YEARLY PROGRESS AND COMPOSITE INFORMATION

## TELPAS ALTERNATE YEARLY PROGRESS INDICATOR

This value will indicate the proficiency level progress if the current year record can be matched to a previous year record. This field will be blank if a match was not made.
$0=$ The student's composite rating is lower or the same as the previous year's composite rating.
$1=$ The student's composite rating is one level higher than the previous year's composite rating.
$2=$ The student's composite rating is two levels higher than the previous year's composite rating.
3 = The student's composite rating is three levels higher than the previous year's composite rating.
$4=$ The student's composite rating is four levels higher than the previous year's composite rating. Blank = No student record match was made to the previous year.

* The yearly progress indicator is set to 1 if a student is BASIC FLUENCY in the current and previous year.

The process for calculating the composite score for the TELPAS Alternate assessment uses the proficiency level ratings for each domain. Each proficiency level rating is assigned a score from 1 (Awareness) to 5 (Basic Fluency). The TELPAS Alternate composite score is calculated using an equal-weighed average of the four individual domain scores.
