New projects funded as of 11/27/12 (reference CRDM New Project Log as of 01/16/13) as well CRDM balance report as of 01/16/13. Current CRDM balance available for funding is \$804K, as \$2.8M is being held in reserve for known needs.

Central Plant Expansion Contingency Return (for informational purposes only)

Kelly Buehler, Sr. Project Manager provided an update to the committee regarding the contingency return on the installation of the new transformer at the Central Plant, total cost \$50K. Contingency balance to be returned is \$362,976. Substantial completion date of the project is September 2013.

Optometry Structural Project

David Laws, Project Manager, provided a presentation regarding Optometry structural damage. J.T. Vaughn Construction, LLC is the selected contractor. The total project cost of this project is \$1,014,885; David requested \$894,259. Committee unanimously approved project funding request. The Presentation will be posted on the CRDM website.
