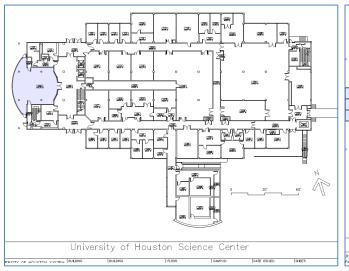

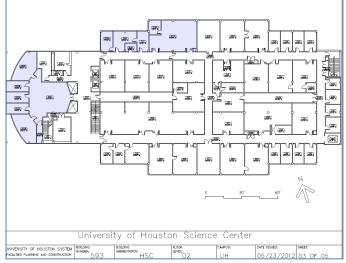

593 Texas Center for Superconductivity Carpet and Paint

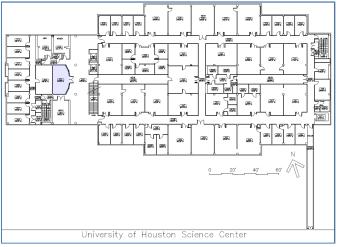
- Issue: Carpet and Paint are worn, dated and prove to be a trip hazard.
