



**Campus Recreation and Wellness Center (CRWC)  
Faculty/Staff Memberships- Payroll Deductions**

- Memberships paid through Payroll Deduction will be available during the entire year.
- The first month of your membership will need to be paid in advance.
- The Initial commitment for a CRWC membership is a one year term beginning on the date that you purchased your membership. After one year, your membership will continue in month-to-month terms until cancelled by you in writing.

**12 Month Employee who takes classes**

Employee/Student	\$0.00 (paid on fee bill)
Employee + one	\$264 yr/\$22.00 mthly
Employee +two	\$396 yr/\$33.00 mthly
Family rate	\$756 yr/\$63.00 mthly
