The New York University Silver School of Social Work invites applications at the Clinical Assistant Professor/Clinical Associate Professor level for a candidate to serve as full-time Coordinator of our St. Thomas Aquinas College Program, beginning in September 2011 or earlier if possible.

The position is a renewable 11-month non-tenure eligible position which involves close collaboration with the Associate Dean for Academic Programs/MSW Program Director and others members of the School's senior management team. The successful candidate will be responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Silver School's 75-student MSW program located on the campus of St. Thomas Aquinas College in Sparkill, New York. Duties include arranging course schedules and staffing, oversight of advisement and field placements, outreach to prospective students, and liaison with St. Thomas and the community.

An MSW degree and a doctoral degree in social work or a related field are required, as well as at least three to five years post-master's agency-based or educational experience. The candidate must have management and teaching experience in social work graduate education and be knowledgeable about a wide range of social service and health care settings. Other desired experience includes program development, management, evaluation and supervision, as well as student advisement and recruitment.

The Silver School of Social Work is an international leader in social work research and education. Located in New York City's Greenwich Village, and in one of the world's great urban research universities, the School offers outstanding support for scholarship, teaching and service. The School offers a BS program with a major in social work and several associated minor and service learning programs; an MSW program that offers an advanced concentration in direct practice with individuals, families, and groups; and a Ph.D. program that prepares scholars to provide the intellectual leadership for the next generation of social work.

Located on Washington Square Park, the Silver School is one of the 14 schools and colleges of New York University, one of the foremost private, global research institutions in the USA. The University attracts students from all 50 states and more than 100 nations. In addition to its main campuses in New York City, NYU also has a portal campus in Abu Dhabi and 10 international academic centers.
