<b>Job Description</b>	<p>Baylor College of Medicine is seeking a full-time case worker or case manager with at least two years' experience to work with the BCM Adult Cystic Fibrosis Center. The BCM Adult CF Center provides care for nearly 300 patients and is located in Baylor Clinic at the heart of the Texas Medical Center. Cystic fibrosis (CF) patients struggle with mental health and psychosocial difficulties, as well as finding and maintaining consistent and appropriate insurance resources, all of which impact overall health greatly. We are looking for an individual who works well in a multidisciplinary team to provide the care and assistance these patients and families need. This position will also work with the Transition Medicine Clinic, a medical home for adolescents and young adults with special healthcare needs. While all primary responsibilities will lie in the Adult CF Center, this position will provide coverage for the Transition Medicine Clinic, as well as work closely with the social workers in that Clinic to share resources and have a common knowledge base and peer group. Attendance in both CF and Transition Medicine Clinics as needed or required.</li> <li>• Attendance at weekly operations meeting and patient care huddle.</li> <li>• Collaborate with physicians and team members as part of a cohesive team care model.</li> <li>• Participation in CF related quality improvement and research projects.</li> <li>• Serve as back up resource for the Transition Medicine Clinic social workers.</li> </ul>
