Job Description	<p>Provides direct clinical supervision to the Child Sex Trafficked (CST) advocates, volunteers and interns as well as case management support to victims of all forms of human trafficking. S/he will serve as a liaison between the YMCA and key partners of the Houston Regional Child Sex Trafficking Continuum of Care and the Houston Rescue Alliance to ensure a coordinated and high quality response to the needs of victims. Duties include: recruit, screen, select, train, and supervise CST advocates, interns, and volunteers; provide clinical supervision and support to CST staff; function well within a multi-disciplinary team format; facilitate access to community resources for victims; maintain a database of all clients referred to program; work with advocates and survivors to create comprehensive service plans; conduct weekly team meetings; participate in task force education and community awareness events; respond to hotline calls on a rotating basis; and provide case management support to adult victims and minor victims of labor trafficking, as needed.
