Job Description	<p>Lilith Fund is seeking a Social Worker in Houston, TX who will co-create, launch, and staff a new Client Engagement Program (CEP). The CEP will require the Social Worker to design creative ways to engage the communities we serve and support our clients along their post-abortion care journeys. They will develop and implement strategies to address and center our clients' needs and experiences; provide emotional support; facilitate a variety of therapeutic activities; foster client leadership in areas of advocacy and organizing; and connect clients to community resources.</p> <p>Primary Responsibilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish and coordinate a new program to lead and develop program activities and protocols related to client resource connection and emotional support; act as client advocate and helps clients gain access to resources • Work collaboratively with Hotline Coordinator and members of the Lilith Fund's board to develop program criteria, intake models, databases, tools, reporting, and client retention • Develop and maintain thorough knowledge of referral resources throughout the service area; develop and maintain relationships with local abortion clinics • Maintain accurate and timely records, including clinical progress notes and program status updates • Facilitate therapeutic peer groups and individual therapy sessions with clients • Work in partnership with clients to develop plans for emotional and personal growth • Determine opportunities to work collaboratively with clients on their journey to strengthening their advocacy for abortion rights and reproductive justice • Foster creative therapeutic environments and facilitate opportunities for clients' self-expression and healing, such as: art therapy, musical and cultural expression, storytelling workshops, journaling, etc. • Work collaboratively with the Lilith Fund Organizer on alignment and opportunities between areas of work; collaborate with Organizer to develop leadership development curriculum and pipelines to integrate clients' leadership within Lilith Fund • Manage and support volunteers assisting with Client Engagement Program
