Job Description	<p>The Trauma and Grief (TAG) Center at Baylor College of Medicine, Department of Pediatrics, Section of Psychology, seeks to fill a Clinical Social Worker position housed within one of our Texas Children’s Pediatric outpatient clinics.</p> <p>This 40-hour per week appointment is designed to ensure greater access to mental/behavioral health among youth seeking treatment in primary care settings. The position will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • implementing evidence-based assessment and trauma-informed interventions for traumatized and/or bereaved youth, ages 7 to 17, including youth who may have a history of other traumas such as exposure to Hurricane Harvey; • training and dissemination of these practices nationally as part of a series of trainings hosted by our TAG Center, a Category II Treatment and Service Adaptation Center of the National Child Traumatic Stress Network; and • collaborating with treatment developers to support monitoring of fidelity to treatment and refinement of interventions to ensure cultural appropriateness.
Qualifications	<p>EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS Master’s degree in social work from a school accredited by the Council of Social Work Education is necessary.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS Clinical practice concentration and field practicum or recent work experience in health care agency or hospital and some experience in professional social work is necessary. Qualifications for this position include skills, training, and motivation required to provide direct clinical work in evaluating and treating bereaved and/or traumatized children and adolescents. Applicants should have documented training and/or recent clinical supervision in evidence-based trauma-informed interventions. Fluency in Spanish is strongly preferred, but not required.</p>
