<b>Job Description</b>	<p><b>Overview:</b> This position provides mental health and/or substance abuse treatment counseling services to Avenue 360 clients which includes but is not limited to individual, group, and/or family counseling services.</p> <p><b>Duties and Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Maintains a regular and predictable work schedule; however, this position is "on-call" at all times.</li><li>• Communicates with others (internally and externally) to provide, exchange, or verify information, answer questions, and address issues of clients.</li><li>• Accomplishes clinical assessments and treatment planning, evaluations to assess the need for treatment, establishes treatment goals and selects appropriate treatment techniques, on the basis of problems and needs of clients and families/caregiver(s), which will be most effective.</li><li>• Develops specific clinic or program treatment goals such as (1) developing communication patterns with members of other disciplines, and (2) determining priorities for services and the method of services (whether in areas of direct services, consultation, or participant teaching.</li><li>• Familiarity with HIV/AIDS, substance abuse services and treatment, homeless services, and other community resources.</li><li>• Objectivity and self-discipline to avoid emotional involvement in situations that is frequently emotional and high-charged.</li><li>• Keeping abreast of new knowledge and techniques related to the practice of mental health therapy and new medical treatment modalities as they might affect the social adjustment or lifestyle of clients via literature, professional settings and staff development activities.</li><li>• Documentation of services provided in client record and required database(s).</li><li>• Performs quality management/assurance activities.</li><li>• Working with male and female heterosexual partners together in three to five facilitated sessions to include "protecting us," relationship fidelity, need to reduce HIV/STI risk among couples, communication and negotiation of safer sex, promote mastery in couple communication, and problem-solving and goal setting skills to the learning, performance, and maintenance of behaviors to reduce HIV/STI risk.</li><li>• Other duties as assigned.</li></ul>

<b>Qualifications</b>	<p>Education, Experience, Licensure/Certification, and Skills/Abilities Related Requirements:</p> <p>Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) within the State of Texas.
