Post Adoption Resource Specialist will develop a network of therapists, respite providers and treatment facilities with experience in special needs adoption. Post Adoption Resource Specialist will provide information and referral services to DFPS post adoption families and other post adoption families (international, private) that reside in Fort Bend County. Case management consists of planning and coordination of post adoption services to an adopted child and their family in order to help the family and child adjust to the adoption, cope with any history of abuse in the child's background, and avoid permanent or long-term removal of adopted children from the family. The identification of community resources and/or creation of resources to support needs of adopted families is the primary goal.
