<b>Job Description</b>	<p>LCSW, LMSW, LMFT, LMFTA, LPC, LPC-I, or LPA to provide bilingual/Spanish language therapeutic services to child sexual abuse victims and their families. Modalities include individual therapy, group therapy, play therapy, and family therapy. Clinician will also be involved in treatment planning, evaluation of traumatized children, crisis intervention, consultation to other multidisciplinary team members, and civil and criminal court testimony.</p> <p><u>Examples of Job Duties:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provides individual therapy, group therapy, play therapy, and family therapy to child sexual abuse victims and their families</li> <li>• Provides crisis intervention when necessary</li> <li>• Provides court testimony in civil or criminal cases as requested</li> <li>• Participates in multi-disciplinary case staffing and consults with partner agency personnel.</li> </ul>
<b>Qualifications</b>	<p>Masters Degree is required in a field related to mental health, such as a Masters Degree in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Counseling Psychology, or Clinical Psychology. Candidate must possess either Temporary or Full Clinical Licensure. Candidate must have a minimum of one year clinical experience. Candidate must have knowledge of abuse populations, trauma, attachment, child development, crisis intervention, psychotherapeutic techniques, and have the ability to communicate well orally and in writing. Clinician must be fluent in Spanish and English and have an understanding of cultural issues in the Hispanic community related to parenting and child abuse and neglect.</p>
