The ideal candidate will collaborate with appropriate LIDDA staff and Transition Support Team (TST).</p> <p>The IDD Crisis Intervention Specialist:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Will collaborate with the service coordinator to identify individuals who exhibit repeated and severe behavior disturbances that jeopardize the individual's safety or current living arrangement</li><li>• Identify prevention strategies to avoid potential crisis events and to promote the individual's coping skills</li><li>• Identify training and support needs that provide the greatest chance of success of living in the community, such as scheduled respite services or planned crisis respite to avoid a potential crisis event</li><li>• Support service coordinator's on-going follow-up and monitoring activities, including assisting the service coordinator, other members of the service planning team, and paid provider, if any, in addressing concerns and issues identified during follow-up and monitoring visits, such as involvement with law enforcement or emergency room visits</li><li>• Provide education about the manner in which to engage individuals with IDD and their unique needs to members of an MCOT, law enforcement, and others as appropriate.</li><li>• The CIS will be available to provide consultation to MCOT as needed and develop criteria for referring an individual with IDD in crisis to crisis respite</li><li>• Develops a crisis respite service plan describing he</li></ul>

	<p>therapeutic support needed by the individual, crisis respite relapse prevention activities, including assisting with transition to the community.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Documents all activities, collaboration, and consultation provided in accordance to DADS expectations</li> </ul>
