	<ul> <li>DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: the Safe Repatriation Social Worker's primary responsibilities include:</li> <li>Manage all Young Center directed international home studies across multiple sites. In collaboration with the repatriation project team and case supervisors, the Safe Repatriation Social Worker is expected to gather the relevant information needed to prepare for international home study requests and coordinate internal and external stakeholders in order to execute international home studies;</li> <li>Identify and secure additional international home study providers;</li> <li>Prepare and process home study contracts, including billing paperwork and report translations;</li> <li>Coordinate internal and external case consultations on safe repatriation cases;</li> <li>Research resources in children's communities in the country of origin and, in collaboration with case supervisors, connect repatriated children and their families to local community service providers;</li> <li>Collaborate with case supervisors to draft safety plans designed to assist the child in reintegrating into their community;</li> <li>In collaboration with case supervisors, organize follow-up communication and correspondence with children, their families, and service providers after children's repatriation;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Track, compile, and analyze data to present to repatriation team;</li> <li>Draft case summaries and outcomes for quarterly reports; and,</li> <li>Other duties as assigned.</li> </ul>
