<b>Job Description</b>	<p>This position is responsible for providing direct services to clients who have a primary substance abuse diagnosis or a co-occurring disorder. Services include individual and group counseling, family counseling, couple counseling and psychoeducational groups.</p> <p><b>Clinical Services</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide one -two hours weekly of individual therapy to assigned clients. (Case load approximately 1-2)</li> <li>• Facilitate or Co-facilitate clinical and chemical dependency groups (2-3 groups weekly),</li> <li>• Facilitate/supervise client study of recovery-oriented materials and offer support/guidance (weekly on Saturdays.)</li> <li>• Act as advocate and liaison w/other service providers and staff members when appropriate</li> <li>• Provide crisis counseling, suicide assessments and support as needed to clients</li> <li>• Complete chemical dependency and mental health evaluations as needed</li> <li>• Conduct chemical dependency assessments</li> <li>• Develop treatment and discharge plans for new residents</li> <li>• Provide services aimed at relapse prevention</li> <li>• Provide individual and group services</li> <li>• Provide educational programs</li> <li>• Participate in treatment and discharge planning for clients</li> <li>• Maintain up-to-date medical record notations</li> </ul>
