The Facilitator is responsible for ensuring all materials and program components are coordinated prior to program implementation. The Facilitator is responsible for ensuring all children or caregivers participating in the JoH program are counted as beneficiaries. Reporting on beneficiaries is coordinated through the Program Coordinator who collects the attendance forms from the Facilitators on an agreed-upon basis (suggestion: Monthly).
