Job Description	<p>(DART) Crisis Counselors provide crisis-counseling, assessment, support, and advocacy services to complainants who are involved in family violence in office or a satellite location.</p> <p>Duties include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact victim 24-48 hours of DART scene visit or after charges have been filed with the Family Violence Division of the District Attorney's Office. • Work within a multi-disciplinary team for best client outcome in high risk domestic violence cases. • Serve as liaison between victims and prosecutors, as well as law enforcement personnel. • Assess client in relation to risk, protective factors, and emotional well-being. • Assist client in formulating a safety / stabilization plan. • Devise brief treatment plans and provide crisis intervention. • Counsel with client for stress reduction, stabilization and crisis intervention. • Assist with initiating protective order applications. • Provide education and referrals to client. • Serve as a liaison with partner agencies to facilitate and coordinate long term client services. • Complete case documentation. • Follow-up with client to assess plan implementation and provide additional support and/or referrals as needed. • Provide expert witness testimony as needed. • Serve as on-call DART team back-up one weekend per month. • Other relevant job duties as they arise. • Ability to work with a multi-disciplinary criminal justice team. • Work from a strengths-based, trauma-informed, and culturally-competent perspective. • Ability to work with a variety of clients with diverse needs. • Ability to efficiently manage large caseloads. • Excellent in-person and written communication skills.
