This position will involve providing technical assistance to select organizations throughout the state involved in implementation of the HCBS-AMH project. TIEMH serves as the primary implementation support for HCBS-AMH. As a part of that support, TIEMH provides technical assistance to 1) organizations applying to be a HCBS-AMH provider or recovery manager, and 2) to organizations implementing HCBS-AMH as a provider or recovery manager. This role will involve a variety of complex activities and strategies driven by implementation science. Implementation will take place across the state and will require regular travel. ### Purpose

The person filling this position will provide technical assistance in the implementation of the Home and Community-Based Services-Adult Mental Health (1915i) including organizational support for implementation and state guidance on project efforts.

Coordinate the policy academy to prepare organizations for the open enrollment application process and documentation / up front administration duties needed for the project. Provide support around tool development, as needed by organizations to contribute to the overall effectiveness of the project. Provides regular onsite and/or virtual technical assistance to community organizations as they prepare to implement or are in the process of implementing services and/or service coordination. Provides technical assistance and support to organizational administrators and managers to enhance their implementation through changes in organizational policies and practices. Utilizes data to identify needs for quality improvement through the coordination of plan, do, study, act (PDSA) cycle and develop state and/or local quality improvement plans. Provide organizational support through community asset mapping, gap analysis, stakeholder outreach and partnership development, process mapping and other implementation measures. Develop and disseminate state-wide support on training curricula and other implementation documents and supports Prepares reports for project funders and presentations or publications for dissemination of information related to the project. Other related functions as assigned.
