Job Description	<p>Arrow Child & Family Ministries is seeking a Therapist for our specialized foster care program dedicated to children who have survived commercial sex trafficking (CST). Selected therapists for this particular program will be responsible for the design and implementation of therapeutic treatment for children and their foster families. This includes, but is not limited to, establishing treatment plans, monitoring progress, consulting with other treatment team members and referring entities, conducting clinical groups, providing crisis intervention as needed, and ensuring that foster parents maintain compliance with all regulatory standards. The position is also responsible for integrating Arrow Child & Family Ministries' approaches into all aspects of the treatment strategies.</p> <p>ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING</p> <p>Other duties may be assigned as necessary.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitates placement of children in foster and adoptive homes and will develop and ensure proper discharge planning when appropriate and necessary. • Provides consultation, instruction and direction to other staff, clients and referral agencies. • Participates as an intake team member in assessing potential clients. • Identifies client's initial treatment needs and develops individual treatment plan in conjunction with client and foster family; oversees and ensures treatment plan implementation with foster family and assigned parties. • Provides direct clinical services to clients to include but not limited to individual, group and family therapy • Completes written documentation of ongoing treatment of children and progress through discharge. • Participates in training of foster parents, volunteers and staff. • Participates in case planning conferences, multi-disciplinary team, court hearings, staffing, etc. • Provides crisis intervention as needed to prevent escalation of high-risk behavior, relapse, hospitalization, placement disruption and other negative outcomes and serves on an on-call rotation. • Maintains appropriate and accurate records for grant reporting purposes. • May be required to drive ACFM vehicles, be insurable with our auto insurance provider, and complete Arrow's vehicle training • Perform all duties within contract, state and federal regulations, Arrow policy, and COA standards.
