Note (1) Fee will increase Fall 2009 to a total of \$120.00.

Note (2) As of the 2005-06 academic year the former dedicated student union fee transitioned to a designated tuition allocation. Allocation amounts as designated tuition are calculated from the former fee base amount with allowances added for needed increases i.e. salaries, utilities etc. minus any deductions that may be made.

Note (3) Angelo has extended services to operate facility year round - 365 days - as part of their Residential Campus Plan. As a result, costs have increased for labor, utilities and to operate food services under this new plan. Angelo will approach SGA spring 2009 for an increase in their semester fee by an additional \$25.00 to meet the higher operating costs. They will request this increase to go into effect fall 2009 if approval can be secured on this shorter timeline.
