- I. Student Project Introduction and Lunch
- II. Student Presentation
 - a. Students presented on best practices and recommendations for an energy policy for the campus. Students profiled select buildings on campus to determine current status of energy practice on campus. Their observations resulted in recommendations for accountability, data gathering and smart metering, and developing an energy master plan for the campus.
- III. Discussion
 - a. Several questions and recommendations followed the presentation. Highlights are as follows:
 - Students recommended 6 strategies for energy demand and prioritized motion sensors and LED lighting retrofits for current buildings
 - Students recommended 6 strategies for energy supply and prioritized solar power production
 - Members of the Facilities Management team are currently developing an energy master plan
 - Transparency was discussed and data publication will be explored further
 - Newer buildings have the potential to be optimized for best practices as an example for the rest of campus and will be explored
