International Travel Insurance

Effective March 1, 2023, the University of Houston System has partnered with On Call International to provide services and benefits while traveling internationally for *all* UHS employees and students.

The program will provide services including, but not limited to:

- Pre-trip planning
- Telephone advice
- Full-scale medical and security evacuations

Key features of the program

- Medical, travel, and security assistance, including insured evacuation services
- International medical expenses coverage
- Coordination of emergent and non-emergent medical care

Travelers can make a collect call, send an email, live chat, or text On Call from anywhere in the world 24 hours a day to request assistance regardless of the nature or severity of the situation.

Authorized Operations Contact (AOC)

Individuals from the university who should be contacted in the event of an international emergency involving a traveler.

- First and primary point of contact for On Call, but
 - Only if there is a medical or security emergency for an international traveler
- Authorized to make a financial expenditure on UH's behalf, but
 - Only if there is a billable service being requested by the traveler
- May be contacted by On Call 24 hours a day, but
 - Only if there is an incident with the traveler

Information Only Authorized Operations Contact

- Someone who has a "need to know" about medical or security emergencies
- Will not receive phone notifications
- Will be included on all email notifications and updates throughout a case

Each department/college should name individuals who would be contacted if there is an incident with a traveler from their department/college. Email Ally McDonald in Risk Management to advise who the AOC or Information Only AOC is no later than April 30th, 2023



International Travel Insurance

While traveling

If travelers need medical care, encounter a travel problem, suffer a medical emergency, or are impacted by security crisis anywhere in the world, we strongly encourage them to take advantage of services available through On Call.

If there is a critical incident alert issued for a traveler's reported location, if it is a high or extreme risk then certain contacts at the University of Houston will also be automatically notified.

- Dependent upon the nature of the incident, the traveler may receive a text, email, and/or a
 notification from the App with a request for a check-in to acknowledge whether they are safe or
 require assistance.
- It is important they acknowledge the message as soon as possible so On Call can prioritize where help is needed and coordinate a quick and efficient response.

Drones

S.A.M. on Drones (01.F.02)

- New UHS policy that regulates the operation of drones on UH properties
- An application is required with requested documentation
 - Two different applications one for UHS employees and one for vendors

Drone Insurance

- Liability insurance is **required** for all UHS owned drones.
 - Sovereign Immunity will not cover fully for motor driven equipment/vehicles, and may not in other states.
- UHS RM purchased a drone policy to ensure our owned drones are covered for liability only while in the US.
 - All drones need to be reported to UHS RM
- If outside the US there may be limited or no coverage for drones.
 - Contact UHSRM if travelling internationally with a drone
- Physical Damage coverage is available, but the drone must be scheduled with UHS RM and there is a higher premium to pay.
 - Contact UHSRM for a quote if physical damage is needed
