Information Security Updates

- Use of Hosted / Cloud Services
 - SAM 07.A.08 - Data Classification & Protection
 - Hosted Services Checklist – Contracts
 - Reminder: Zero-cost solutions still require protections!
 - Examples: Current non-UH data breaches involving UHS data
 - University-Provided Services
- Email requests – former employees, employees on leave, etc.
 - SAM 07.A.07 – Use of Electronic Messaging by Employees
 - Plan ahead when addressing employee separations/terminations





2-Factor Authentication is Coming!!!

- Required by many different companies including retailers and banks
- Something you know + something you have = access
 - Requires users to validate their identity through a second means such as a registered cell phone or via a passcode
 - IT Support Center can generate passcodes or initiate push notifications for users having trouble.

Email Protection is Here!!!

- ProofPoint implemented in July
- Significant reduction in Malware, Job/Gift card Scams, Impersonations
 - In past 2 weeks – 197 gift card/job scam emails blocked
 - Last night – Cisco job scam sent to 160 UH students blocked!
- Configuration issues and status:
 - Third-party senders (ConstantContact, MailChimp, etc.)-**RESOLVED**
 - Quarantine Settings
 - Low-priority bulk email filtering – Turned Off 08/11-**RESOLVED**
 - Multiple User Digest Messages-**OUTSTANDING**
 - @uh.edu + @central.uh.edu

*****Ongoing efforts to fine-tune the mail system to be more efficient & effective**

Face to Face Instruction- Fall 2020

- HyFlex Classrooms – 259 classrooms (so far)
 - Computer or Laptop
 - Camera
 - Microphone
 - Sound System
- Students attend:
 - Face to Face with social distancing - reduced room capacity
 - Synchronously Online via Desktop Video (Teams)
 - Recording available for students unable to make class

Synchronous Online – Fall 2020

- UH has two approved platforms
 - Teams is licensed for all Faculty, Staff and Students
 - Zoom licenses are purchased through UIT

 - Would you accept the liability of teaching a class in you Livingroom or renting a room off campus and directing your students to go there for class?
- Can you share Zoom licenses?
 - Yes, but remember that recording is problematic.
