Director of Interior Architecture Job Description

The director:

- oversees the daily operation of the undergraduate interior architecture program
- collaborates with the Director of Industrial Design, the Director of Architecture and the Director of Graduate Studies.
- works with faculty members to develop and implement curriculum
- is responsible for supervising, supporting and facilitating the work of the faculty
- represents the architecture program to both internal and external constituencies
- applies leadership skills toward strategic planning for the program, in alignment with the College Strategic Plan and in support of the University Strategic Plan
- advances the development of pedagogy in the IA Program
- assists in the development of the program budget
- assists in the:
 - o recruitment of faculty.
 - hiring of faculty,
 - hiring of staff,
 - hiring of adjunct faculty
- assists and advises in various tasks relating to:
 - o recruitment.
 - o admissions,
 - graduation
 - o internal / external communication
- oversees accreditation reviews

In addition, the director:

- promotes the program nationally and internationally
- engages with national and international peer programs
- advances research and assessments of other undergraduate programs of peer institutions nationally and internationally
- advances the development of program academic year and long-term agendas
- advances the development of programs assessment
- advances the development of program tools (charts, prospectus, pamphlets, others) to promote internal discussions and external communication and promotion
- Oversees digital student work collection
- makes recommendations to the Dean:
 - o on coordination of academic areas and studio levels
 - o on coordinators appointments



- oversees academic and studio coordinators' duties and agendas
- makes recommendations to the Dean:
 - o of faculty teaching loads and distribution

- assists institutional requests of program
