INTERDICTION FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN is designed to make **front-line officers and investigators** aware of the variety of resources available to assist them in establishing the status of a child who may be missing, exploited, or at risk of exploitation and what courses of action are immediately available.

FREE two-day training course • 16 hours TCOLE credit • Students are responsible for their own meals

Upon completion, attendees will:

- Know resources available to them and courses of action to take when encountering an endangered child.
- Be able to identify research supported indicators of an endangered child and a high risk threat to children.
- Have a basic understanding of behavioral patterns of both suspects and victims.
- Know how to articulate their findings that are supported through research.
