

Cougars in Recovery students will apply in the summer for consideration as a scholarship recipient for the upcoming Fall and Spring semesters. The scholarship application and essay are to be submitted on or before July 7th, 2021 by 11:59 PM (CST). <u>Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.</u>

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Enrolled at the University of Houston as a full-time student (12 credit hours for undergraduate and 9 hours for graduate students) in previous Fall and Spring semesters.
- One year of continuous abstinent based recovery from addictive and/or compulsive behaviors.
- Program participation expectation:
  - Community Check-In Attendance
    - Attending 100% of scheduled Community Check-In's for Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters
  - Social component
  - Attending CIR Recovery Tailgates in Fall semesters
  - Participating in the CIR Community Photo
  - Attending scheduled Community Gatherings

- Connecting with CIR staff and community members (*Including, but not limited to: Community Check-In's, Outdoor Adventure Learning Experience, off campus fellowshipping, etc.*)
