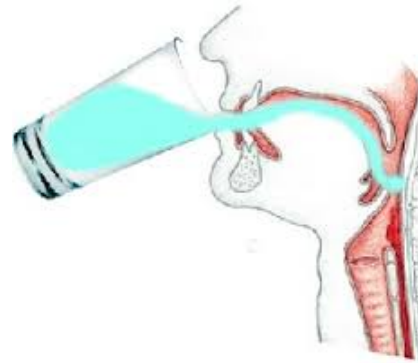

## **SwIFT Clinic**

(Swallowing Intervention/Feeding Therapy)

**Ages 3 years – Adult**



The Swallowing Intervention/Feeding Therapy Clinic (**SwIFT**) offers dysphagia assessment, education, and intervention for children, adults, and caregivers. Our program focuses on providing evidence-based treatment to individuals with feeding and swallowing difficulties. Our goal is to serve as a resource in our community for education on swallowing dysfunction, guidance on diet recommendations, and completion of compensatory and restorative treatment. **SwIFT** is a specialty clinic provided by the University Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic (USLHC). Graduate clinicians provide evaluation and therapy services under the direct supervision of certified and licensed speech-language pathologists.
