



FRENCH PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS
John and Wanda Martin French scholarship
Academic Year 2022-2023

The French Program will award scholarships to students at the University of Houston who have demonstrated academic excellence in, and significant commitment to, the study of French.

For the year 2022-2023, 2 scholarships of \$2,000.00 each will be awarded.

Eligibility requirements:

- Enrollment in a French course during 2022-23 academic year.
- Enrollment as full-time student.
- Preference given to declared French majors and minors, and to students enrolled in the Learning Abroad Angers program.
- Return to UH in Fall 2023 **and enroll in a French course** (to be verified).
- GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Recipients are also eligible for the Ann B. Simanton Award, but not for other French scholarships for the 2022-23 academic year.
- Preference given to students who did not receive a French scholarship in 2022.

Application process:

- Submit application form and a one-page statement in English (Times new Roman 12pt font, double spaced), stating the reasons for the application. Please submit both your application form and your statement in ONE PDF file, and name the file as follows: YOUR LAST NAME.2023 SCHOLARSHIP. **Please submit only one application for Silin, John Mitchell and John and Wanda Martin scholarships.**
- Any application not submitted in the proper format will be rejected.
