

3.200 international students


Classical comprehensive university:





# **Semester dates**

#### Academic Year Winter term and Summer term October to Sepember

#### Winter term Semester October 1 to March 31 Lectures and exams until February





#### Summer term

Semester April 1 to Sepember 30 Lectures and exams mid July

# **Exchange application procedure**

#### STEP 1

Apply at University of Houston for the exchange with Leipzig: http://www.uh.edu/learningabroad/find-a-program/exchangeprograms/

STEP 2 Apply at the Leipzig University for admission May 31 (winter term) /December 1 (summer term)

#### STEP 3

Get your acceptance letter, apply for housing and start to prepare for your academic schedule until orientation

#### STEP 4

Start your Leipzig experience with the language and orientation course or directly with the semester
