Criteria for selection include the following (nominees do not necessarily need to meet all the criteria):

1. Outstanding performance *in a challenging work situation, especially in 2018 – 2021* [Note: this is not a lifetime achievement award];
2. Demonstrated commitment to ethics and ethical decision making;
3. Places welfare of citizenry above personal, professional, and political motives;
4. Demonstrated public service values in actions;
5. Addressed problems beyond his/her jurisdictional boundaries; and/or
6. Maintains harmonious and supportive relationships across jurisdictional boundaries.

Nominations will be accepted through **November 1, 2021.**
