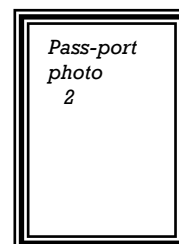
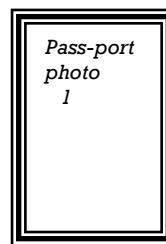

Tentative program fee (discount possible depending on number of students)

Learning Abroad offers International Education Scholarship (IES). Application for Summer 2020 programs open December 1, 2019 and are due February 23, 2020. Eligibility criteria:

- Must have completed 12 UH credit hours*, have a minimum 2.5 GPA*, and be in good academic standing.
- Must NOT have received the IES before.
- *Credit hours and GPA *at time of application*. First-semester and new transfer students are not eligible to apply during their first semester at UH.

The airfare is not included. Students should make their own arrangements to arrive in Seville by Friday, May 29 in the morning or early afternoon.

The Price includes:

- Bus transportation to Cádiz on May 31 and back to Sevilla on Friday June 27
- Two-night stay in Sevilla May 29-31 with cultural visits, professional flamenco show and some meals included
- Housing with a family, 3 meals included, laundry
- Classes at the University of Cádiz
- All class materials
- University certificate
- MundoLengua tutoring
- Orientation walks
- Torre Tavira visit
- Day trip to Puerto Santa María
- Cooking class
- Surfing lesson
- Farewell luncheon

Tentative Itinerary

Thursday May 28, 2020 (or before) - DEPART U.S. Students must make their own arrangements to arrive in Sevilla by midday on **Friday May 29, 2020**.

As mentioned above, **we will start our program in Sevilla. Meeting point and hotel information in Sevilla will be available at one of the mandatory Orientation sessions held in April and May.**

Our program is from May 29th till June 27th. Classes in Cádiz will run from June 1-25, 2020. We will go back to Sevilla on Friday, June 27. Plan to depart Sevilla to any other destination on **Saturday, June 28th**.

Classes are Monday-Thursday 9:30-2:00pm.

Program Conditions

Payment Terms

General

- Once you submit your application form no later than Feb. 28, 2020, you agree to pay the full amount. The payment will appear in your UH bill. You have until March 22 to withdraw your application without any penalty (see cancellation policy below). The total program price is due preferably by the beginning of the program.
- We need a copy of your passport and two passport size photos.

Regarding Accommodation

- The student will be charged for the replacement of items broken due either to negligence or intention on the part of the student.
- The student may be charged for the replacement of locks if the host family's keys are either lost or stolen due to negligence on the part of the student.

Regarding Expulsion

- In the case of a serious disciplinary offense, or infringement of one of the Program Rules or Student Conduct Abroad Agreement, MundoLengua and/or the University of Houston reserve the right to expel the student from the program (both school and accommodation components) without any refund of unused portions and/or components of the program. The student will also be responsible for any fees associated with the return to his/her home country.
- Students are also responsible for the cost of damages caused to third parties as a result of student infringement of the Program Rules and/or Student Conduct Abroad Agreement.

Regarding Cancellations

- If the student cancels from the program after March 22 and before April 19, 2020, we will refund him/her all monies paid less applicable transaction costs (\$150.00).
- If the student cancels from the program from April 20-May 28, we will refund him/her all monies paid less \$300 dollars.
- No refunds will be paid once the program has started.

Program Rules

1. Students will respect and uphold family rules. Activities such as inviting guests to the host family's home, smoking inside the home, use of the family's telephone, and, if applicable, use of the family's Internet, must be approved by the family.
2. Students will not drive cars, motorcycles or scooters at any time during the program. In order for a student to drive any off-road motorized vehicle, the student should make a request to the director.
3. Hitchhiking or soliciting a ride from a stranger is prohibited.
4. Students must take responsibility for all personal property; MundoLengua cannot be held responsible for any student's personal property that is lost or stolen.
5. Students will not discuss their host family's private affairs with anyone other than a MundoLengua representative.
6. Students cannot change their host family without permission from a MundoLengua representative and the UH director.
7. Students must obey all local and national laws.
8. Use of illegal drugs, or association with anyone involved with illegal drugs, will result in the student being returned to his/her home country, without recourse and at the student's expense.

Mandatory Medical Insurance

All students participating in a Learning Abroad program are required to have international medical and emergency insurance. UH has partnered with Cultural Insurance Services International (CISI) to offer the most cost –effective and robust international insurance package available to our students. **4-weeks coverage @ \$ 39.65**
