## **Application Instructions**

A complete Application includes the following:

- 1. Complete both sides this coversheet.
- 2. Provide the following short essays in a separate Word or PDF document:
  - a) Explain your involvement in college organizations, community activities, honors, special awards, etc. Please include any leadership or community/civic participation (300 words maximum).
  - b) Career Goals (200 words maximum).
  - c) Financial Need: explain the circumstances of your financial need (200 words maximum).
  - d) Personal statement: Why do you believe you deserve a scholarship? (500 words maximum)
- 3. Secure a letter of recommendation from a CLASS instructor familiar with your academic work
- 4. Secure a current academic advisement report (also known by professional Advisors as a Degree Progress Report). You can find instructions for accessing the report here:

- 5. If applicable, secure official transcripts from each outside college or university that you have earned **less than**30 hours of course work while at UH.
