CAMPUS SAFETY TIPS

ON CAMPUS

When walking after dark, use the "buddy system," and stay in well-lit areas.

If the outdoor warning siren sounds, seek shelter indoors.

Keep your contact information up to date in the UH ALERT System.

Report suspicious activity to UHPD by calling 713-743-3333 or 911.

Know where emergency phones are on campus.

Access the UH late-night Cougar Ride service through UH Go or contact UHPD at 713-743-3333 if you need a safety escort.

Listen to your music at a level where you are able to pay attention to your surroundings.

Make sure a roommate or friend knows your whereabouts when you go out.

IN YOUR RESIDENCE HALL/APARTMENT

Close your blinds or curtains after dark, and never dress in front of a window.

Keep a record of serial numbers of computers, printers, televisions, stereos and other valuable possessions.

If the fire alarm sounds, leave the building immediately.

If cooking in your kitchen, stay focused on your cooking.

Keep your door locked at all times.

Program your phone's speed dial to include UHPD.

Secure important documents such as bank statements, credit card bills and other personal information.

IN PARKING ZONES AND GARAGES

Know where the emergency phones are located in your parking area.

Report issues using "Lot Spotter" QR codes.

Stay in the designated lanes and follow directional signage.

Before you park on campus, register your vehicle for your virtual parking permit so your vehicle is authorized to park.

Report accidents in UH parking zones and garages to UHPD at 713-743-3333.

Leave your phone alone to avoid accidents.

Registered toll tags or physical/digital Cougar Card are required for parking gate access.

Secure your parked vehicle and keep valuables out of sight.

Register for CoogPark to stay updated on parking and shuttle information.

Pay attention when walking through the parking areas.

IN STUDENT CENTERED SPACES

If the fire alarm sounds, leave the building immediately.

Be aware of your two nearest building exits in the event of an emergency.

Register your bicycle/scooter with the University and secure it with a quality lock before entering campus buildings.

Protect personal information, including your Cougar Card credential (digital and physical).

Be aware of your surroundings.

If you see something, say something by reporting concerns to UHPD 713-743-3333.

Take your personal belongings with you (purse, backpack, laptop, phone, Cougar Card, etc.) even if you are stepping away momentarily.
