University of Houston commits to sharing available, actual whole project energy and water usage data for the subject LEED project. This commitment will start upon certification acceptance and will continue for at least five years.

We will compile project-level energy and water usage data into monthly and annual summaries and share this data on a regular basis with GBCI and USGBC using a free, accessible, and secure online tool. We will use reasonable efforts to ensure that this commitment carries forward in the unlikely event that the University sells its historic Roy Cullen building.

We understand that if the LEED certified project is later altered in such a way that the data for the original LEED project becomes impractical to collect, we will no longer be required to share or provide access to the data.
