Persistent Identifiers (PIDs) are REQUIRED

- Federally funded grants **require** you to have a **persistent identifier (PID)**
- An **ORCID iD** is a **persistent identifier**, and meets that requirement.
- ORCID iDs** are already **required** for the following federal agencies:
 - National Institute of Health (NIH)
 - Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ)
 - Center for Disease and Control Prevention (CDC)
 - National Science Foundation (NSF)

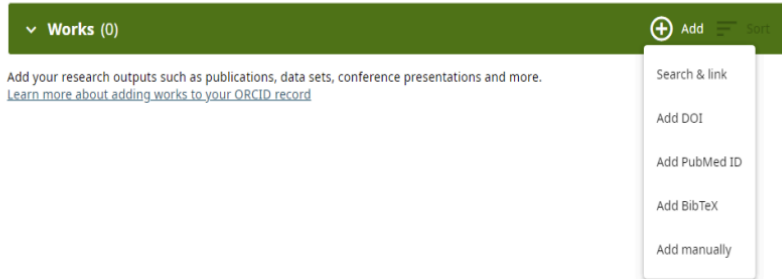

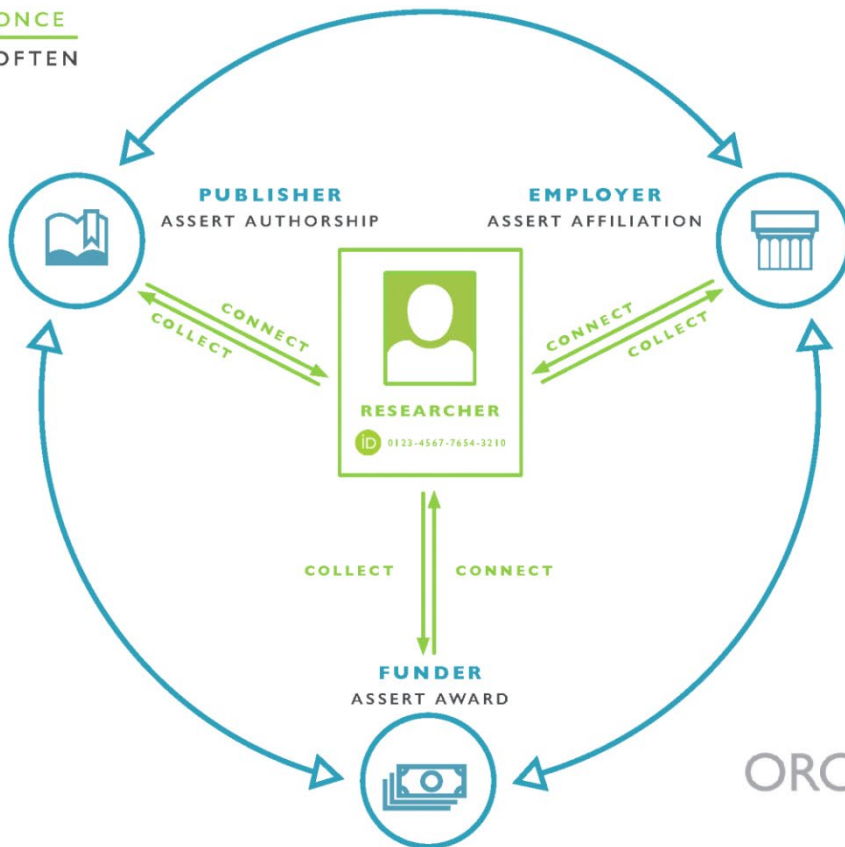
- Connects ORCID iD to the manuscript/dataset
- Connects ORCID iD to Datacite, SCOPUS profile, Web of Science, enables auto-update

- Embed ORCID iDs in metadata when manuscripts/dataset is accepted, noting if iD is authenticated

- Checks metadata for authenticated ORCID iDs when assigning DOIs to new works

- Receives new work information from Crossref/ DataCite, SCOPUS, & Web of Science.
