# Report from and Discussion with the University of Houston System Senior Vice Chancellor and University of Houston Senior Vice President for Administration and Finance: Raymond Bartlett

SVP Raymond Bartlett reported on the following items:

- Mr. Raymond Bartlett emphasized how the CFO and Provost working effectively together helps support UH's mission and the President's vision. He commented that he is thankful for Dr. Chase's collaboration with his division.
- Future Funding Model in Texas: The current model is based on enrollment and isn't sustainable (cyclical decreases and small increases). UH is having conversations on new business models. CFO Bartlett ensured that he will always make sure the budget is balanced.
- Campus Centennial Task Force Meeting takes place this Friday, April 19.
- A vendor has been selected for the new HR applicant tracking system. This will take several months to implement.
- FY2025 budget is a work in progress, and the final draft will be presented to the BOR meeting in May.

There were no additional nominations from the floor. Dr. Shattuck informed that voting will be conducted online and eligible faculty will be notified by email when the polls are open.

#### 2024 Faculty Senate Officer Slate:

Dr. Shattuck announced that the Faculty Governance Committee isn't ready to present the Senate officer and Faculty Governance Committee slates and asked the Senate for a one-month delay. Doing so would require making an exception to the Constitution mandate.

The related section of the Constitution of the Faculty Senate reads:

"By the April meeting of the Senate, the committee shall present two nominations for the positions of president-elect and secretary, and four nominations for the two at-large positions on the executive committee. The committee shall also present fourteen nominees to fill the twelve elective positions on the Faculty Governance Committee."

FGC Chair David Shattuck brought forth a motion that there be an exception to the Faculty Senate Constitution to allow the nominations for the president-elect, secretary, and at-large positions on the executive committee and the Faculty Governance Committee to be presented at the May 2024 meeting of the Faculty Senate. He said that this motion required a second. The motion was seconded and the floor was open to discussion. Senator Donna Pattison mentioned that this procedure had been done in the past.

Vote by acclimation: The Faculty Senate voted unanimously to pass the motion.
