## A Resolution to Prevent Academic Charges From Being Applied to a Student's Fee Bill Long After the Disbursement of Financial Aid

Whereas: All academic charges such as tuition and fees should be determined well in advance of financial aid disbursements,

Whereas: Many students rely on financial aid disbursements, received at the beginning of each fall and spring semester, to pay their tuition and fees,

Whereas: It is unjust and economically discriminatory to assess such fees significantly after financial aid has been distributed and students have already budgeted their money for the semester,

**Be it resolved:** That no tuition or academic fees will be billed after the first week of classes for the semester to which the charges pertain, unless the additional charges result from registration for additional classes by the student.
