At the May 12, 1982 meeting of the UHCC Faculty Senate the following resolution was passed without dissent.

Faculty Senate Resolution

Whereas overhead funds generated through research and training grants are, under Texas legislative policy, not generally made available to the universities and their faculties, and

Whereas the Texas Legislature has in recent years failed to fund organized research requests at 100% of the approved formula amounts, and

Whereas those deficiencies taken together result in significant shortages of greatly-needed research funds,

Therefore: The Faculty Senate supports efforts on the part of the Chancellor and President to initiate and cooperate with actions intended to effect needed changes in State policy which would permit universities to retain and use funds generated by overhead for research purposes, and to fund organized research at 100% of the approved formula, and

The Faculty Senate offers to work with the Administration in these efforts in such manner as the Chancellor and/or President may request.

If the faculty may help you in any way in your efforts to retain overhead funds for the university please let me know.
