- Whereas there is widespread faculty opposition to the newly promulgated graduate faculty standards, and
- Whereas there is fair evidence that the changes in graduate faculty standards were elicited under duress and possibly false pretenses, and
- Whereas neither the body nor the larger academic community have been presented a rationale for these changes, and
- Whereas, as a result, neither this body nor the larger academic community has had the opportunity to debate the reasons for and those against the aforementioned changes and
- Whereas as changes in graduate faculty at least in some academic units must be -but have not been- adopted through by-laws amendment procedures, be it therefore
- Resolved that the Office of the Chancellor be requested to halt immediately implementation of proposed and/or promulgated changes in graduate faculty standards, and be it further
- Resolved that the Office of the Chancellor be requested to undertake forthwith those steps necessary to at least correct the procedural defects enumerated above.
