* The Faculty Senate of the University of Houston opposes the Administration's reduced support for Student Services (Counseling & Testing, Career Planning & Placement).

These key academic-support units have been removed from state funding "to provide money for faculty/staff raises," we are being told. Their reduced funding will come out of Student Service Fees.

* The Faculty Senate opposes the abolition of the Office of Handicapped Student Services, whose very existence is being threatened by SSFPAC cutbacks.

* The Faculty Senate opposes granting the request of UH Athletics for a SSFPAC fund increase from this year's \$1,700,000 to \$2,000,000 in 88-89.

The Faculty Senate supports raises for faculty and staff - but not the sacrifice of units closely linked to the academic goals of the university.
