III Undergraduate Committee Chair Elections: Simon Bott, Chair of Ad Hoc Nomination Subcommittee

Simon Bott announced that Larry Williams and Lori Selzer were the nominees for the chair position. The UC voted by written ballot and elected Larry Williams as the new UC Chair.

Larry Williams thanked the Committee and mentioned that he would like Reagan Herman to continue on as vice chair of the Committee.

IV Diana Velez, Director of Undergraduate Scholars, CORE 1101 Annual Report

Dr. Diana Velez presented the annual report on CORE 1101: College Success with regard to the fall 2012 FTIC cohort. She gave a brief summary of CORE 1101. She informed the UC that this program is a hybrid course and it is currently going under review and changes are being made (i.e., reconstituted learning outcomes such as the critical thinking component, adding a financial literacy component, and a research component).

V Administration Representatives' Reports

A Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid, Sal Loria

The Office of Scholarships & Financial Aid awarded 410 million dollars of financial aid to UH students this week. UH will award about 450 million dollars by next week. Four hundred Tier One scholars for the fall 2013 were invited to apply for this scholarship. Two hundred students received Tier One scholarships since the beginning of the program. Fourteen million dollars in academic excellence scholarships/grants were awarded to 2300 students.

B Office of Admissions, Steve Soutullo on behalf of Djuana Young

For Fall 2013, 8600 FTIC students have been admitted. All ethnicities are up in admission numbers, except for African American applicants. The average SAT score has increased by eight points. Also average class rank has increased.

C Office of Registration and Academic Records, Debbie Henry

An automated grade change workflow process has been created (grade change icon will be available in the faculty center for faculty to utilize this new process) and will go live early April 2013.

Acalog implementation has begun. By the end of May 2013, UH will have a new catalog template for the Fall 2013 - Summer 2014 catalog edition. The Curriculog workflow piece will be implemented in the early fall. Debbie informed the UC that this automated workflow will cause a substantial culture shift in requiring the colleges, departments, and UC subcommittees to review/approve items earlier in the academic year. Submitting, reviewing, and approving UC items earlier will enable the catalog to be published in early May and be available for new students during orientation.

D Academic Affairs, Libby Barlow

Libby Barlow provided a summary of the First Year Experience pilot program. UH needs to analyze what students are thinking in a holistic and efficient manner. This pilot program will follow the Fall 2013 cohort. Students will be enrolled in foundational courses which contain a heavier academic component (mostly core courses). First Year Experience will focus on FTIC that are living on campus and excludes athletes, music majors, and honors students. There will be a residential life component and a pilot coaching program (peer coaching) added.
