#### OVERVIEW

The **University of Houston Graduate School** is hosting the university-wide **Graduate Research Showcase** virtual poster session starting March 1, 2021. This event is intended to showcase the breadth and depth of groundbreaking research being undertaken by UH graduate students across disciplines, as well as to offer opportunities for cross-disciplinary networking. The event will feature a virtual poster session. The top 10 graduate student winners will be eligible to receive a \$250 scholarship award.

#### Poster Session

The poster session will feature virtual posters by graduate students. While poster presentations are common to some disciplines (STEM, education, etc.), the goal is to encourage participation across the university and to include all areas of research. No particular format for the posters is required and each will be considered in relation to the research or creative products associated with its discipline. The Graduate School will work with students to help prepare them for this opportunity. The posters will be judged by a panel of judges from a variety of disciplines.

#### Submission Criteria

The graduate student applicant should have research experience, the ability to communicate their research to a lay audience and should be a registered graduate student (masters or doctoral level) in good standing with their respective college.
